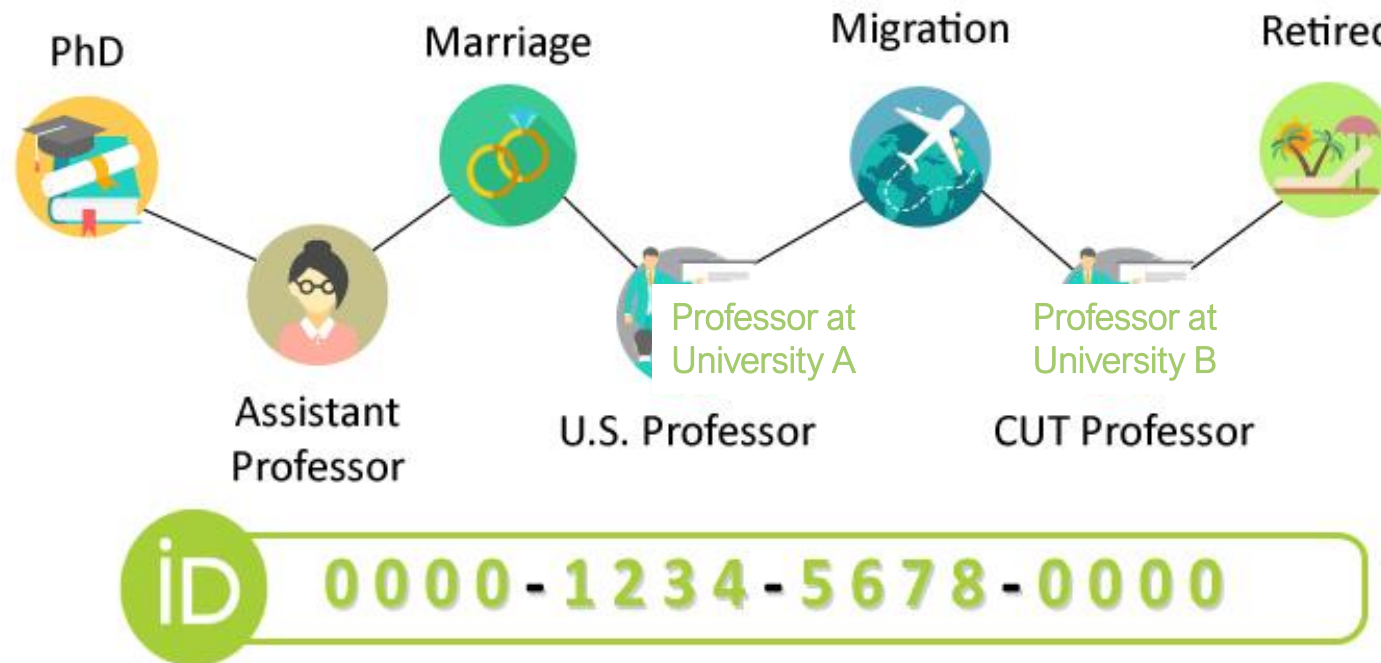
- **ORCID**[®] (Open Researcher & Contributor ID) is an international, interdisciplinary, open and non-profit organization. Its main goal is to provide a unique identification for researchers.
- The **ORCID iD** is a nonproprietary 16-digit code to uniquely identify scientific and other academic authors and contributors. It aims to classify authorship and facilitate name disambiguation.

He was Head of the Department of Public Services and Reference Librarians at the University Library of the University of Veterinary Medicine Vienna; Head of the Novartis Knowledge Center Vienna as well as Global Project Manager for the Novartis Institutional Repository Project & Open Access Champion at Novartis; and also ran his own information consultancy business focussing on project management in the field of new trends in scholarly communication, especially Open Access. Furthermore Christian was Coordinator of the Council of Austrian University Libraries from 2010 to 2020. Since 2020 he is Head of Department for Bibliometrics and Publication Strategies at the University of Vienna.

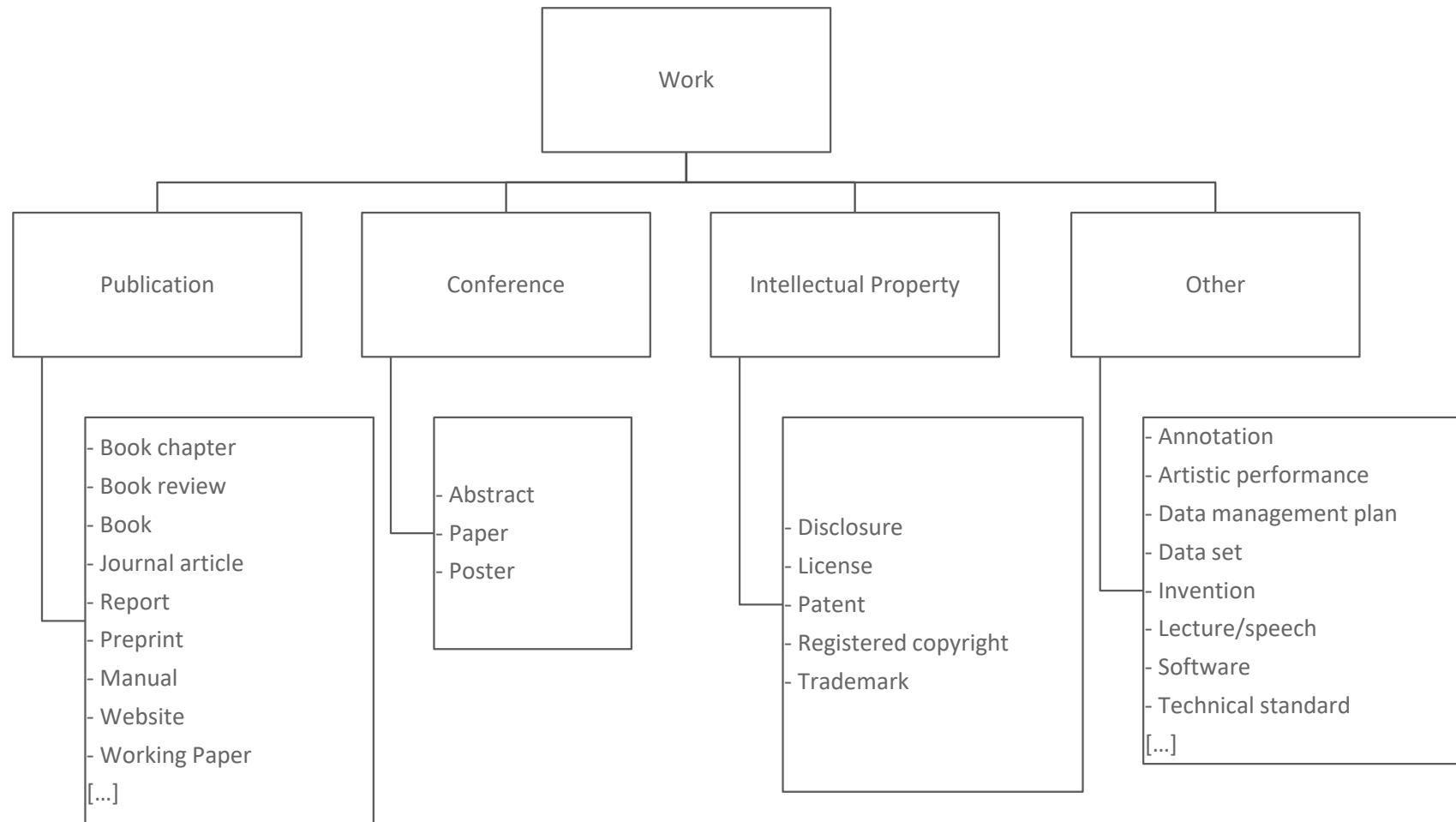




How to set up an ORCID record (via u:cris)

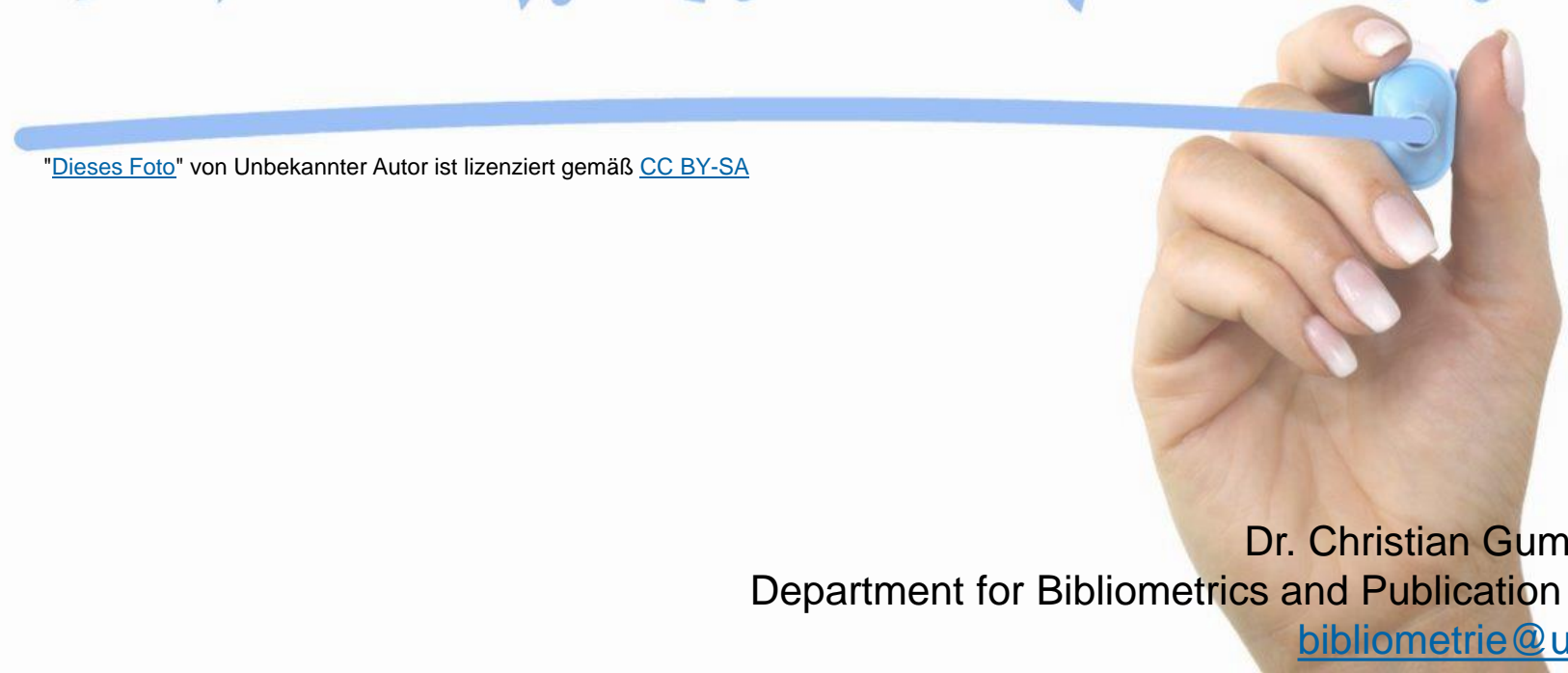
- **Increased visibility** of your research activities
