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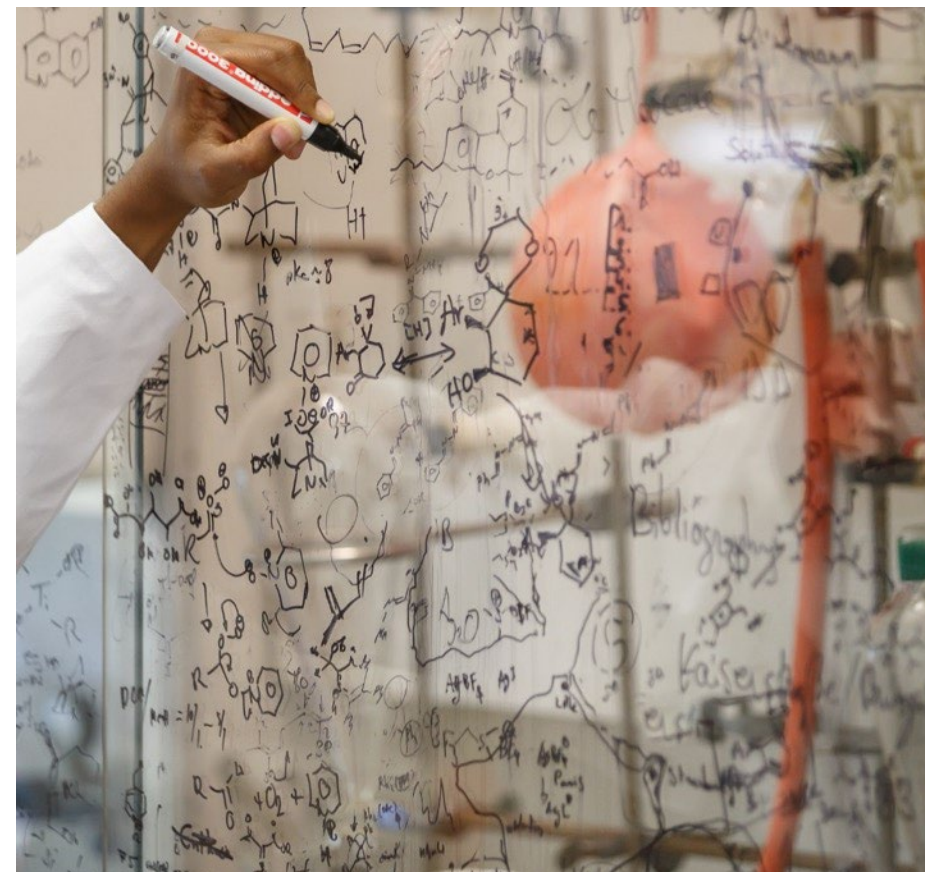

Quality Assurance in Research

- **International (informed) peer review**
 - Publications | grants
 - Researcher: hiring, promoting, evaluating and retaining
 - Research units: evaluated every 7 years
- **Doctoral education & schools**
- **Supervision | (Peer) Mentoring**
- **Research Integrity & Ethics | Open Science | Researcher Assessment – CoARA**
- **Quality Culture = Quality assurance is the task of all members of the University in their area of responsibility**

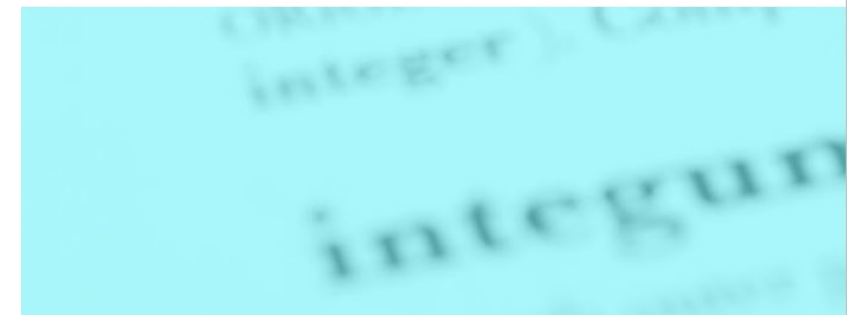
Principles of Good Research Practice

- **Reliability** in ensuring the quality of research, reflected in the design, the methodology, the analysis and the use of resources.
- **Honesty** in developing, undertaking, reviewing, reporting and communicating research in a transparent, fair, full and unbiased way.
- **Respect** for colleagues, research participants, society, ecosystems, cultural heritage and the environment.
- **Accountability** for the research from idea to publication, for its management and organisation, for training, supervision and mentoring, and for its wider societal impacts.

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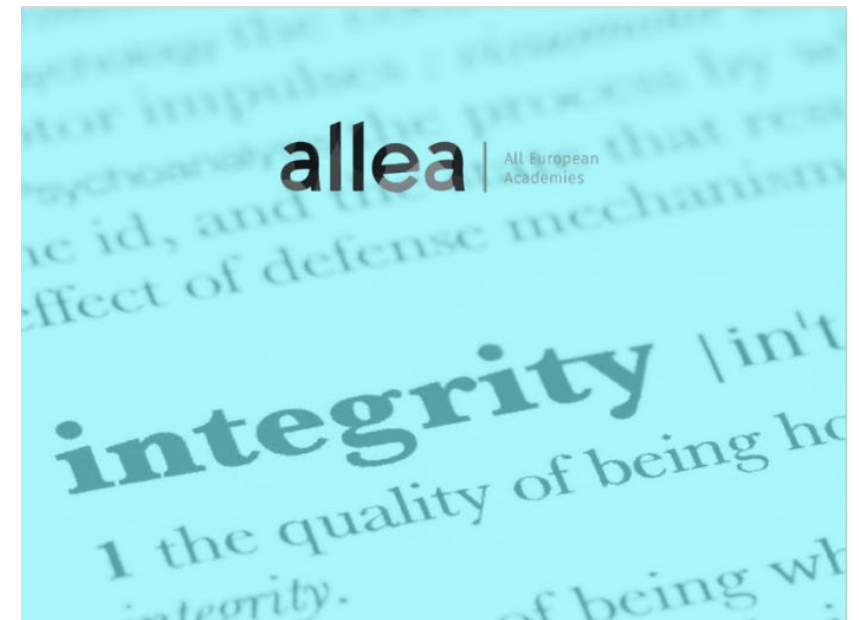

Research misconduct: FFP

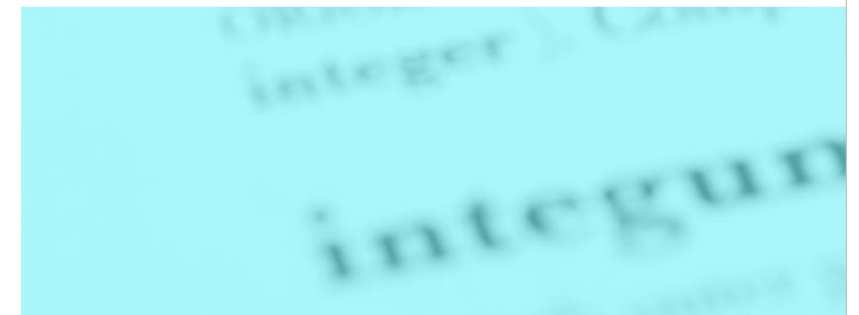
- **Fabrication** is making up results and recording them as if they were real.
- **Falsification** is manipulating research materials, equipment or processes or changing, omitting or suppressing data or results without justification.
- **Plagiarism** is using other people's work and ideas without giving proper credit to the original source, thus violating the rights of the original author(s) to their intellectual outputs.

These three forms of violation are considered particularly serious since they distort the research record.

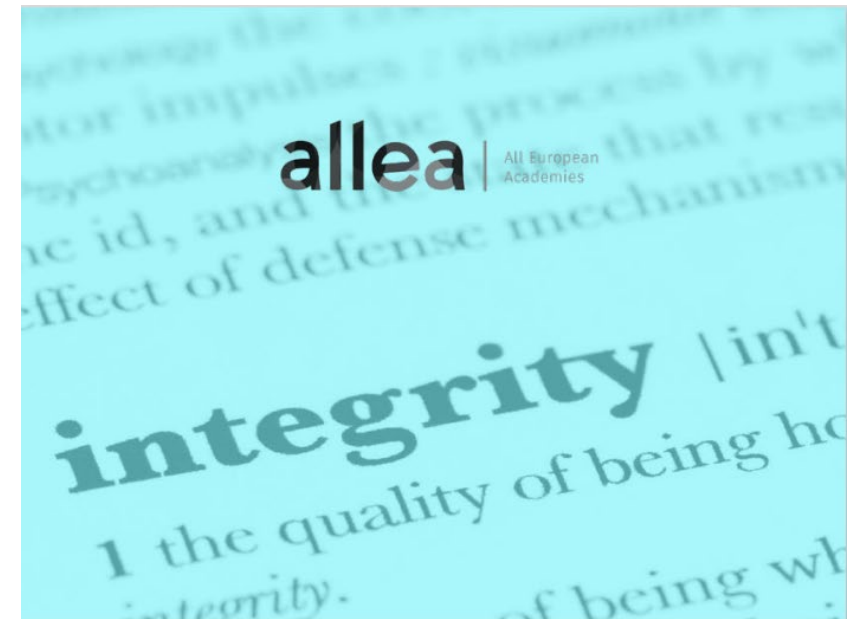
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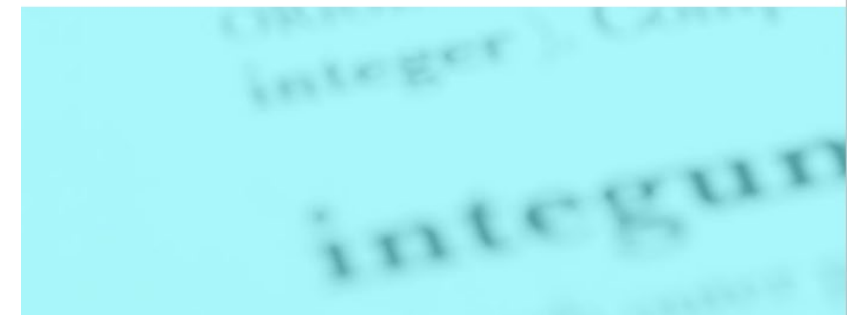
Other unacceptable practices include

- **Manipulating authorship** or denigrating the role of other researchers in publications.
- **Re-publishing** substantive parts of one's own earlier publications, including translations, without duly acknowledging or citing the original ('self-plagiarism').
- **Citing selectively** to enhance own findings or to please editors, reviewers or colleagues.
- **Expanding** unnecessarily the bibliography of a study.
- **Exaggerating** the importance and practical applicability of findings.



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Guideline UoV for Good Scientific Practice

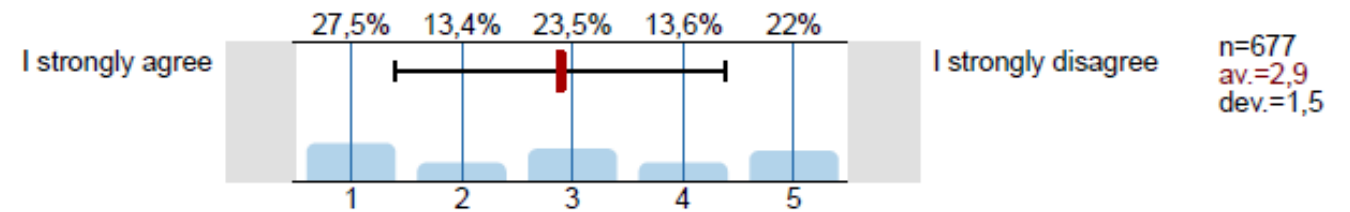
- *The University of Vienna acknowledges its responsibility by instructing early stage researchers on the principles of good research conduct and practice.*
- **Compliance with guideline is required through:**
 - Statutes of the University of Vienna: Study law
 - Doctoral thesis agreement
 - Working contract (if employed)



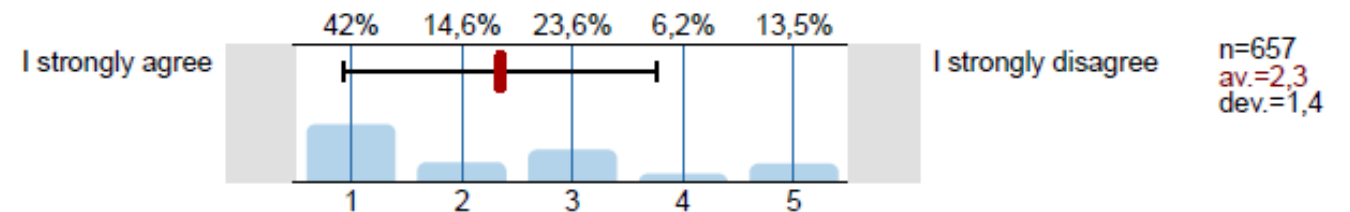

My supervisors also support me in writing **research proposals for acquiring third-party funding**.

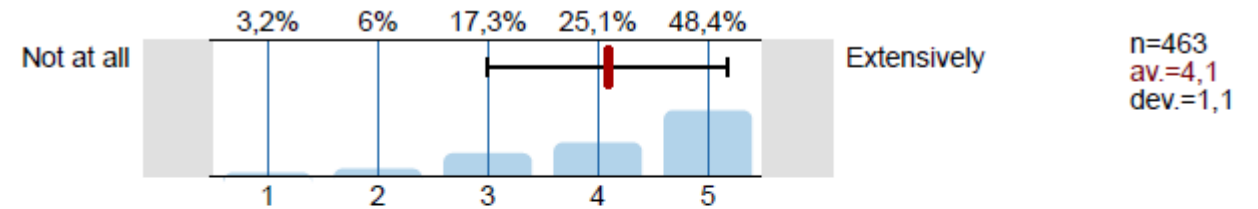


My supervisors clearly clarified the **authorship** in joint academic publications.

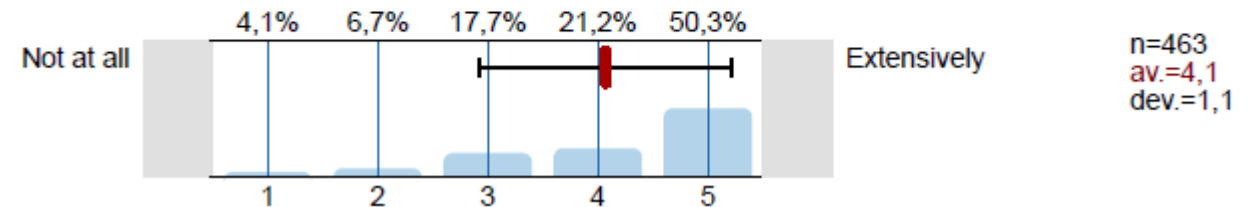


Survey of doctoral graduates @UoV: To what extend did the doctorate teach you the following principles and practice?

Correct handling of data (no invention or falsification of data, securing and storing primary data, etc.)

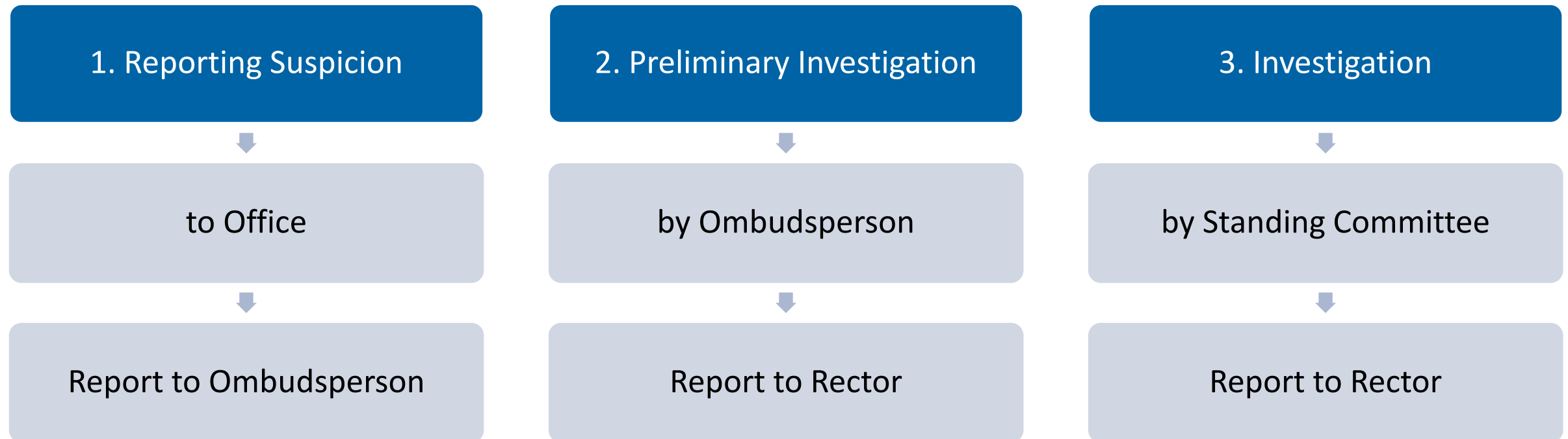
