<u>Basic info:</u> course in blended learning format (combines on-site sessions with online learning), introduction to issues relevant to teaching your first course (general framework for teaching, course design, methods, assessment & networking opportunity) – see https://ctl.univie.ac.at/basisqualifizierung/

<u>Target group:</u> All staff new to teaching, mandatory for predoc university assistants (collective agreement §49). This obligation does not apply to persons with prior teaching experience in higher education.

Target group:
